

Event Regulations – Carnival Ball at the National Stary Theatre

These regulations apply to the Carnival Ball organised by the National Stary Theatre on **7 February 2026**, from **8:00 PM to 2:00 AM**, at the National Stary Theatre in Kraków.

1. The Carnival Ball is a dance event. Purchasing a ticket and participating in the event constitutes acceptance of the following rules, which are intended to ensure the safety and comfort of all participants.
2. Participation in the event is open to individuals holding a valid admission ticket. The organiser may request presentation of the ticket at the entrance.
3. The event is open to persons aged **16 and over**. Minors may participate only when accompanied by an adult guardian, who is responsible for them throughout the duration of the event.
4. Ticket prices are as follows:
 - until **22 January 2026**: 30 PLN
 - from **23 January 2026**: 50 PLNTickets are available online via the theatre's website and at the MICET box office. On the day of the event, the box office will be open until **11:00 PM**. On-site ticket sales will be subject to availability.
5. The Carnival Ball will take place simultaneously in the Modrzejewska Hall and the BE Zone. Participants are free to move between the different spaces.
6. Participants are asked to treat one another with respect and consideration.
7. Bringing alcohol or other intoxicating substances onto the event premises is prohibited. A bar will be available on site, where beverages may be purchased.
8. Smoking is strictly prohibited on the theatre premises, including the use of electronic cigarettes.
9. Participants whose behaviour poses a risk to the safety or comfort of others may be asked to leave the event. Such decisions are made in the interest of the well-being of the entire event community.
10. Participants are requested to follow the instructions of the organisers, event staff and security personnel. These guidelines are intended to ensure a calm and welcoming atmosphere throughout the event.
11. The organiser is not responsible for personal belongings left unattended.

12. During the event, photographs and video recordings may be taken for documentation and promotional purposes by the National Story Theatre. Participation in the event constitutes consent to the use of one's image in this context.
13. The organiser reserves the right to make organisational changes (e.g. to the schedule or use of space) if necessary to ensure the smooth and safe running of the event.
14. Matters not covered by these regulations are governed by the internal regulations of the theatre and applicable laws.
